

Lambton Queen of the Furrow Contest

- Contestants must be 19 yrs of age by IPM 2023 and have not reached their 25th birthday by IPM 2024. Entries to be submitted 2 weeks prior to Match
- Must be single
- Plowing to be part of the competition. Equipment for plowing will be provided. However any contestant may make their own arrangements for equipment if desired. Each contestant will be required to complete three rounds. Each contestant will be required to provide proof of 2000,000 liability insurance. This is a regulation of the Ontario Plowmen's Association.
- The topic of speech will be the choice of the contestant usually dealing with agriculture. The speech is given at the Banquet.
- The contestant will be asked an impromptu question. Sample questions will be given so you know what to expect.
- Interview day of Match at site
- The winner will represent the Lambton County Plowmen's for the next 2 years at the IPM
- Queen of the Furrow contestants will be the guest of the Lambton County Plowmen's Association at the banquet.

Basis of Award

- Plowing Ability 100pts
- 2-3 minute speech 250 pts
- Appearance and Deportment 200pts (how you present yourself)
- Interview 250 pts

Prizes

- Queen of the Furrow \$60 Plus expenses to compete at IPM for 2 years
- Runner Up \$50
- Additional gifts will be given out at the Banquet.

Duties

- Compete at IPM for the next 2 years in September
- Attend workshops offered by IPM. Attend functions on behalf of the Lambton Plowmen's Association to promote agriculture and the Lambton Plowing Match and IPM.
- Attend and give a report at each meeting. If unable to make it submit a report by email
- You will be reimbursed for expenses incurred as duties preformed as Queen of the Furrow – mileage .45 cents per km
