Municipal Class

Open to Municipal Officials in Lambton County
Contestants must notify secretary on the date of the match

Antique Divisions

Class A Open Antique Drag Plows

Tractors must be 1958 or older and Plow one land per outfit

Class B Open Antique Mounted Plows

Tractors must be 1958 or older (no competition plows)

Class C Open Classic Class

Any Equipment Manufactured between 1959-1980 (2-4 Furrow)

Class D Open 1 Furrow Class

One Furrow plows (open split not more than 12")

Horse Divisions

H-1 Walking Plow

H-2 Riding Plow

Tractor Divisions

Class 1 Open - Over 18yrs old

Open Split 2 or 3 Furrows set not less than 12"

Class 2 Open - 18 yrs or less

Open Split 2 or 3 furrows set not less than 12"

Class 3 Lambton County Residents - Over 18 yrs old

Open Split 2 or 3 furrows set not less than 12"

Class 4 Lambton County Resident - 18 yrs or less

Open Split 2 or 3 furrows set not less than 12"

Class 5 Open Ladies Class

set not less than 12"

Class 6 Lambton County Residents Team

3 or more furrows

1 Junior competitor (20 yrs or younger) & 1 Senior Competitor
(over 20yrs) not less than 14" furrows

Class 7 Open - 4 or more furrows

not less than 14" (open split)

Class 8 Lambton County Resident - 2 or more Furrows

1st and 2nd year plowing contestants (any equipment)

Class 9 Open - Reversible Plows

World Plowing rules will apply for this class

Rules

1. Minimum depth of furrow 6 inches. No tramping of open split and no rolling of furrows.
2. Open Split in all classes. Cast off to highest numbered lot.
3. In all classes a plowman is allowed a coach to assist the first round. The coach must then remain at either end of the field and must not follow across the field.
4. Registration 8:00am. Land Draw 9:45am. Plowing to start 10:00am
5. Entry fee **\$20 to be deducted from prize money.** Includes free breakfast ticket and choice of lunch or banquet ticket to plowmen.
6. Plowmen from outside the county can only plow in Open Classes
7. No competitors from outside of County eligible for Special Prizes.
8. No riders on tractors or plows on the site.
9. Judges decision final.
10. Entry fees will be withheld from class prizes won. Cheques will be given to Jr. Competitors at the banquet; all other cheques will be mailed to competitors.
11. ***Each contestant will be required to submit written proof of \$2,000,000 liability ins min. Liability Waiver Form must be completed in order to plow***

OPA Plowing Rules will be in effect and applicable on Match Day

Prize Money for All Classes (Except Class 4 and 6)

1st \$100.00; 2nd \$90.00; 3rd \$80.00 All others \$70.00

Prize Money for Class 4 —

\$100 to each competitor, regardless of placing

Prize Money for Class 6 —

1st: \$200.00; 2nd \$180.00; 3rd \$160.00 All others \$140
